Nursing & Psychology Major: 35 hours including PSYC 1001, 2001 and 2050, and at least 1 course from at least 5 of the following 8 content areas: Developmental (2101); Social (3201 or 3230); Cognitive Science (4330, 3301 or 3320); Assessment (3701 or 4701); History & Systems (4801); Personality Theories (3501); Physiological (3601); and Abnormal (NURS 3500 and 3501; 3 credits of the Mental Health lecture/practicum count towards Abnormal content; the other 3 credits count as Psyc 4964 for Psyc elective. Additionally, 6 credits from psychology electives are required.
