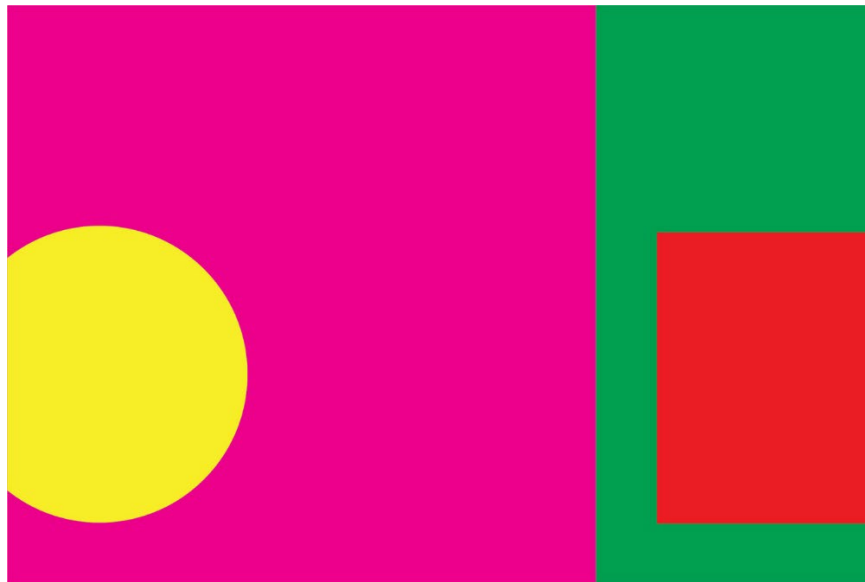
The Haggerty Museum of Art presents

Concealed Language: A Plea for Help

A Choral Concert by The Marquette University Chorus

In collaboration with Marquette University's Family Weekend 2024, the Haggerty Museum of Art will present *Concealed Language: A Plea for Help*, a concert by the Marquette University Chorus. The concert was inspired by the Haggerty's exhibition *SOS Color Code 2024*, an indoor and outdoor installation comprised of flags and changing colored lights based on the dots and dashes of Morse code. The installation transforms the international SOS signal of distress into a sign of solidarity and connectedness and asks its viewer to reconsider how language, symbols, and color can help us find stability and safety in an uncertain world. Following similar themes, *Concealed Language: A Plea for Help* explores the emotive power of choral music and the hidden language within the featured compositions.
